This year we are experimenting with a new method to crown the team champions. It has no effect on who will win individual awards. That stays the same. Only the team title scoring system has changed, but only for the Public Schools. The Non-Public schools team championships will be awarded in the traditional manner.

This year, eight teams are eligible to score team points in this meet. That means that only these eight teams are in the running for the team championships. How were these eight teams selected? They were first or second in their sectional championships. That is why most of the performance lists show more than 24 athletes in each event, because of the “extra team advancers,” a part of the new Group Team Scoring.
